Over the Columbus Day Weekend, twenty volunteers arrived by 8am and donated 220 hours of professional Union labor! Because of their volunteer and organizing efforts, Sunset Park Redevelopment Committee, Inc. will be able to facilitate energy conservation services through the New York State Weatherization Assistance Program for elderly Brooklyn home owner, Mr. Signorelli.

Upon entering the property, volunteers immediately began working, were professional and considerate of Mr. Signorelli's living conditions. In addition to the committed volunteer services, members addressed a two foot hole that rotted the wood beneath the carpet due to a leaking flower pot. The level of consideration to Mr. Signorelli was further extended, with a thorough site cleanup, vacuuming and; commitment to return by some of the attendees, to paint his interior.

It is important to share, that if not for this volunteer effort spearheaded between our office and the Executive Leadership of the Latino Club; most especially Mr. Eddie Herrero and Mr. Ruben Colon, the donated man hours and supplies with a combined estimated value of \$10,500, could not otherwise be funded by the Weatherization Assistance Program or paid for by Mr. Signorelli.
